Usually people use the 12-hour clock in the UK

[*Au Royaume-Uni, on utilise généralement l'horloge de 12 heures*]

The 24-hour clock is used for transport timetables and appointments

[*L'horloge de 24 heures est utilisée pour les horaires de transport et les rendez-vous*]

The 12-hour clock

a.m. [ante meridiem]	10 a.m. = 10 o'clock in the morning	
p.m. [post meridiem]	4 p.m. = 4 o'clock in the afternoon	
		"meridiem" (<i>en latin</i>) = midday
12:00	= 12 p.m. = midday or noon	
00:00 or 24:00	= 12 a.m. = midnight	
In the morning	In the afternoon	At night

How to say the year [*Comment dire l'année*]

1966	nineteen sixty six	The year when England won the football World Cup [<i>L'année où l'Angleterre a remporté la Coupe du monde de football</i>]
1066	ten sixty six	The year when England was invaded by William the Conqueror (Duke of Normandy) [<i>Année de l'invasion de l'Angleterre par Guillaume le Conquérant (duc de Normandie)</i>]
1901	nineteen o one	The year when Queen Victoria died [<i>L'année de la mort de la reine Victoria</i>]
